Did you know...

- 2.5 million U.S. middle and high school students reported e-cigarette use in 2022.
- 1 in 10 drinkers develop alcoholism or other serious alcohol-related problems at some point in their lives.
- 200,000 people seek help each year for marijuana dependence.

What is The Power of Choice?

This educational program is based on Prime For Life[™], a proven curriculum with 30+ years of research. It changes beliefs, attitudes, and perception of risk of drugs and alcohol. Participants are empowered to identify their values and are given clear tools to make low-risk choices to protect what they value.

What to Expect:

- "The Power of Choice" is a drug and alcohol course for anyone making high risk choices, no matter what they've used or why. It is taught in a group format over six hours.
- This class covers the biology and choices that can lead to addiction. Participants learn about phases of addiction and coping skills to support a decision to guit.
- The Power of Choice is taught by trained facilitators and includes local resources for support.
