The SSA Disability Programs and Application Process

- · Learn how the Social Security Administration's (SSA) defines disability
- Emphasizes why working can be good for you and your disability case
- Teaches the similarities and differences between Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)
- · Discusses the application process, its timeframe, as well as how and where to apply

The SSA Application Forms

- Instructs how, when, and where to submit SSA application forms and medical evidence
- Teaches how you should complete the SSA 821 Work Activity Report, the SSA 3368 Adult Disability Report, and the SSA 827 Authorization to Release Information
- Teaches the importance of the SSA 1696 Appointment of Representative form

The Medical Eligibility Criteria

- · Teaches the medical criteria and the five-step determination process
- Teaches how to use this information to explain how a person meets the medical criteria
- Teaches what additional case development can improve the success of an application

Transition from Child to Adult Disability

- Discusses child (SSI) and adult disability (SSI/SSDI) and the transition between them
- Explains the requirements and importance of disabled adult child (DAC) benefits
