2011.434

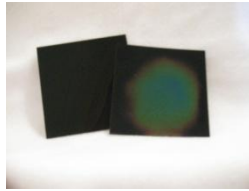
This disco light displays static electricity light and color on it'd dome. Lights congregate at point of contact on the dome. (Image to left)

Heat sensitive squares of paper that product colorful impressions with every touch. (Image to left)



Color Coding Labels

Bright multi-colored circular labels that can be easily written on or printed up on to create high contrast labels for folders and other object. For demonstration only. (Image to left)



Spot 'n Line Pen

2011.526

Liquid pen can be used to mark items providing a visual indicator. Color is neon orange. For demonstration only. (Image to left)



Mini-Aquarium

2011.524

Small aquarium comes with two fish. Must add water for visual stimulation. 2 AA batteries required. (Image to left)



My 1st Bubble Blower

2011.525

Bubble machine, push lever to produce bubbles for visual stimulation. (Image to left)



Find It!

This tube contains 23 items buried among tiny beads. The object is to find the items by manipulating the tube. The tube comes with a list of items that are hidden inside. (Image to left)



Rain Stick

2011.543

Tube that contains multi-colored beads and tower. When flipped over beads will manipulate themselves through the various stationary parts inside the tube. (Image to left)



Giant Sight and Sound Tubes

2011.618

A hands-on way to exploring. Set of clear tubes, each filled with a different object for visual, auditory, and tactile stimulation. Permanently sealed for safety. (Image to left)



Kaleidoscopes

2011.562

Set of six kaleidoscopes. Cylinder with a peep hole on one end and a plastic prism on the other end. Prism will distort the image seen through the kaleidoscope. (Image to left)



Glitter Wand

2011.516

Sensory wand filled with liquid and glitter. 18 inches in length

Ribbon Wand

2011.536

Wand with colorful ribbons attached. Wand handle rattles when shaken. (Image to left)



Light Wand

2011.520

Change light colors, comes with cord so it for convenient carrying. AA batteries required. (Image to left)



Spike Light

2011.405

This convenient book light has a durable clip and is lightweight. Can be clipped to book and arm of light can be manipulated so that the light shines onto the pages. The LED lights provide bright, consistent light for reading. (Image to left)



Living Color Triple Timer

2011.615

Three barrel timer and liquid art that can be used for visual stimulation. Timer can be used for transition or redirection efforts. (Image to left)



Soft Frame Convex Bubble Mirror

2011.544

Square mirror with circular mirrors, shape of mirrors manipulates reflection seen in the mirrors. Colorful soft frame prevents injuries. (Image to left)
