
Financial Overview



Our Programs

ADULT DAY CENTER

Easterseals Adult Day Center enhances the lives of adults while promoting their dignity and independence.

COMMUNITY CENTER FOR THE DEAF—CCD

Easterseals CCD provides interpreting, case management, vocational support, education, advocacy services for Deaf and hard of hearing individuals and Deaf Kids Enrichment Group. We adapt various types of programs and services to meet Individual needs.



HOME DELIVERED MEALS

Easterseals offers Home Delivered Meals to homebound clients in <u>Mahoning and Columbiana Counties</u>.

KINDERGARTEN READINESS

The Play, Learn and Grow Group is developed by therapists to supplement pre-school. This is a structured program open to all children 2.5 to 5 years of age, to help develop the skills needed to succeed in the classroom.

REHABILITATION/THERAPIES

Easterseals therapies includes speech-language, occupational, and physical therapies. Our facility serves infants, children, teens, adults, and seniors so we can meet the therapeutic needs of individuals throughout their life span.

SCHOOL BASED MENTAL HEALTH

Easterseals and Alta Behavioral Health have created a unique relationship to provide mental health services to students with disabilities in several schools.

SUMMER CAMP

Easterseals offers various summer camps. This year three camps were offered: one in Mahoning County and one in Trumbull County for older adults raising children and one for Deaf youth.



TEEN GROUP

Easterseals Teen Group serves teens with disabilities, between the ages of 13 to 21. This program provides the framework to interact and develop friendships.

TRANSPORTATION

Easterseals offers "to the door" transportation for those 60 years of age and older living in <u>Mahoning and Trumbull</u> <u>Counties</u>. We provide transportation to appointments, shopping and our Adult Day Center.
